


Village of Glenbeulah, WI

## WATER & SEWER

The Village provides the public water system and is jointly involved in the Northern Moraine Wastewater Treatment Facility with the Village of Elkhart Lake, unincorporated Greenbush, Sanitary District #1 of Rhine and Plymouth.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

The Village of Glenbeulah is located along County Roads A, A&P, C, and P. The Village is less than 1.5 miles from State Highway 23. The is no rail service in Glenbeulah. The Sheboygan County Memorial Airport is 13 miles away.
